


Surrey Building Control Guidance Note - Number 7



Ground Floors


Ground Bearing Floors



Notes


- 1. These details assume that ground conditions permit the use of a ground bearing floor slab and that ground is free from contamination.
- 2. Hardcore is clean, compact and sand blinded.
- 3. A screed finish could be added to concrete if required. Levels to be adjusted accordingly.

Suspended Ground Floors



Notes

- 1. These details assume that manufacturer's details are followed and that calculations are provided to justify the structural stability of the floor.
- 2. Site should be well drained and not subject to flooding.
- 3. A Damp Proof Membrane (linked to the DPC) may also be required.
- 4. Void beneath floor should be ventilated on at least two opposite sides. Telescopic vents are normally used.
